A short run of approximately 55 miles is an option for veterans, belt driven machines, cycle motors and Senior Citizen riders. The routes will be over metalled roads. Riding numbers and suggested route sheets will be issued at the start. Please note there will be <u>NO recovery</u> service this year. The event is followed by a Concours and Reception. This reception will be held in an area reserved for riders, passengers, officials and sponsors. To access this area the wrist band issued at sign-on must be worn.
